

Goodman Oral Board Preparation: Neurosurgery Review by Case Management

The 2019 American Association of Neurological Surgeons (AANS) Goodman Oral Board Preparation course reflects the changes in the American Board of Neurological Surgery (ABNS) Oral Board Exam. Practicing neurosurgeons who register for the full course will have the opportunity to attend at least four breakout sessions specific to their subspecialty to assist in preparation for the focused practice portion of the exam. Register for this one-of-a-kind course to enhance casemanagement skills, identify knowledge gaps and pass the ABNS Oral Board Exam.

THIS COURSE CONTAINS TWO CONCURRENT SESSIONS:

Plenary "Hot Seat" Sessions: The plenary sessions provide a simulated board exam experience by covering more than 200 case scenarios. "Hot seat" participants formulate responses to mock exam questions, while other attendees observe how best to formulate. organize and present responses to case scenarios. On Day 3, sessions address and analyze attendee-submitted cases in preparation for the case-based portion of the exam, including clinical history, physical examination, key imaging, diagnosis and management, surgical coding, early result and follow-up.

One-on-one Sessions: The one-on-one breakout sessions consist of one participant paired with a faculty member. Experienced neurosurgeons will critique patient management response and the ability to organize answers to simulated oral board questions. The breakout sessions are intensive and comprehensive.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants should be able to:

- Discuss contemporary neurosurgery topics. including general, trauma, spine, vascular, tumor, pediatrics and peripheral nerve.
- ► Comprehend the format of the ABNS Oral Board Exam.
- Compare approaches to standard and complex neurosurgical problems with those of contemporaries.
- Identify those areas of neurosurgery where further study would be beneficial in preparation for the ABNS Oral Board Exam.
